

## DAUPHIN COUNTY MUSIC EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION Senior Scholarship

#### **SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:**

Up to five \$500 scholarships based upon academic and music excellence will be awarded to the three most deserving high school musicians, as selected by the Dauphin County Music Educators Scholarship Committee. Emphasis will be placed on awarding one scholarship to at least one attendee of each of the festivals; Band, Orchestra, and Chorus. The check will be made payable to the student and the designated university. Prior to the distribution of funds, the DCMEA Treasurer will contact the appropriate college or university to confirm the student's enrollment for the following year. Scholarship is for a one-time designated amount of \$500.00. Scholarship will be withdrawn if winner fails to begin his or her higher education career, in a music relate career, at the expected date or designated institution. The scholarship will also be withdrawn if winner changes institutions before the expected date and fails to notify the Scholarship Committee. The scholarships will be presented to the winters at their home school during an appropriate ceremony, if possible.

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Application must be emailed or mailed to DCMEA Vice-President by May 1st, 2024.

Applicant must be...

- be enrolled in a music program in either a public or private school in Dauphin County, where the
  director of the music program is a member in good standing with DCMEA. Any student of a
  director that is not in good standing with the association will not be eligible to apply.
- a graduating senior who is planning a career in a music-related field (i.e. music education, music performance).
- have participated in at least one of the DCMEA Festivals: County Band, County Orchestra, County Chorus.

Verification of application/acceptance from an accredited college, university, or conservatory must be presented prior to receiving the scholarship funds by parent/guardian of winner. Attendance at said institution must begin in the fall semester following the students graduation from high school.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

The scholarship is announced to all participating students in the county festivals by the respective hosts and to the audience by the DCMEA President or Vice-President during the welcome speech.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The Scholarship Committee will consist of:

- DCMEA Vice-President Committee Chair
- DCMEA President DCMEA Secretary
- DCMEA Treasurer
- Hosts of respective county festivals.

The scholarship committee will meet after the deadline date to select a winner.

Each committee member will rank the applicants, and an average will be taken to decide the winner.

The committee chair will contact the winner.

#### **APPLICATION PACKET MUST CONSIST OF:**

- · Recommendation of high school music director
- Recommendation of high school principal
- High School Transcript
- Name of college to which student has been accepted for the study of a music related major.
- An essay about what the student has gained from his/her scholastic music experiences and how he/she plans to draw on those experience in the future.
